- **OLD BUSINESS**
  - NC3 Update, Bob Gray & Kate Greenwood:**

CR 317 - finished. Paved, heavy duty, great base for trail, 4" deep, Miles did good job. Next Goal: working on trail from Johnson Village to Buena Vista. Working with county commissioner's support.

CR 313 – will end at Marquette Av on N, E, NE side. Needs to be a joint project to connect, footbridge on Arizona project (across Cottonwood Creek) is vital link to connect.

Alan Robinson is working with GOCO contact and thus is familiar with process and knows the contact. First grant will be to complete CR 317 from Johnson Village to Buena Vista. Grant application is due in March, currently looking for a letters of support and doing research.

Long Term Goal: Another GOCO Grant for Crossman Av, CR 306, CR 361 loop. Have support from Board of County Commissioners for Conservation Trust Funds and 25% matching funds. Guise, Holman, Potts supportive
- **Public Works Director's report (Greg):**

Attempted to contact **CDOT** TPR (Transportation Planning Region) to reallocate funds for **Arizona**, but will have to back to another meeting in Feb or March. TPR needs definitive schedule and cost analysis, their YES gives the project a GO. Olsen still hasn't gotten back on design costs.

**Hyw 24** starts tomorrow, 3 westerly lanes closed, lights will be re-aligned, completion date delayed to July 4, 2017. A light at Crossman has been designed but not funded.

**Gregg Dr.** IGA with CDOT, everything else is done
- **Ed** – discussion re stocks of Brochures, we will go thru all 10,000 copies. Next year: bigger map. include B. Whipple Trail, identify loops.
- **Emily** – Sept 24 National Public Lands Day, work project on Bacon Bits followed by social at Eddyline Tap Room. Todd L. has GPS'ed Midland Hills Trails, sent to Linda Skinner and Biologist, NEPA will be done by Spring/Summer 2017. \$20,000 budget request (capital improvement) to connect to S. Whipple, possible with DOC crews
- **Adopt a Trail** - Much of this work has been taken care of by Tom (who should be invited to attend meetings). Future updates by volunteers will be only Spring and Fall
- **Nancy** – Trail Advocacy lots more volunteer hours on Bacon Bits
