TOWN BEAUTIFICATION BOARD MEETING

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes from the April meeting were approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Funds

- Beautification funding from Town: \$10,530
 - \$ 3,135 – annual flowers cost 27 planters, 2 self-watering, 4 wood inserts @\$75/each, and 12 small @\$55/each (budget was \$3,600)
 - \$ 4,900 – black metal benches
 - \$ 2,030 – pole wraps
 - Went ahead and purchased 7 wraps – Total was \$1,991.52
 - Balance: \$8,803.48
- Beautification Fundraised Funds
 - Balance: \$3,298.31
 - - \$537 for 2 self-watering planters
 - Balance: \$2761.37

Landscaping Public Works Projects

- Median by fire station
- Public Works will remove the trees in the 3 planters at the end of Cottonwood Street and replant them. They are some kind of dwarf evergreen. They've asked us for ideas on where to plant these.
