GOCO Grant will fund Billy Cordova Park and the trail to connect Peaks View to the park. Contract signed \$750,000.

Collins reported that Buena Vista Single Track Coalition (BVSC) has talked about hosting a ceremony to install a bench dedicated to Nancy Anderson. Richmond will reach out regarding details.

Richmond reported that there 21 posts placed around town lake in which each contains an educational piece making it a story walk.

- Public Works (Shawn) Williams reported that he is still working on a plan for the Arizona Bridge. He will be meeting with engineers to review and see what alternatives are available.

Williams brought up the \$5,000 in the Trail Maintenance budget and asked about using the money for weed spraying.

Walton brought up the fact that the new development near the Black Burro bicycle shop is causing the trail to be moved. Richmond explained that the developer is in fact paying for the trail to be bumped out closer to the river. Construction is underway.

Brief discussion about signage. Collins motioned to remaining \$5,000 plus \$3,500 in budget for signage. 2nd Cole motion approved.

- Trail News (Kelly) Collins reported that Cranken Hammer Trail work is underway. BVSC had a workday last Saturday. It is projected to be completed in August.

VII. Newspaper articles Denison submitted an article about the Adopt A Trail program.

VIII. Other Collins motioned to add Mallory Brooks to the Trails Advisory Board as an alternate.
