TOWN BEAUTIFICATION BOARD MEETING
Thursday, July 11, 2019

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- Minutes for the May meeting were approved.

OLD BUSINESS

Funds

- Beautification funding from Town: \$14,740
 - \$ 3,240 – Annual Flowers
 - \$ 4,000 – Black Metal Benches
 - (\$259.41) – student bench
 - (\$350) – custom linings for student bench
 - \$ 3,000 – 5 Snowflakes
 - \$ 4,500 – 2 Trash Cans
 - (\$2,250) – to SixLine for trash cans
- Beautification Fundraised Funds: \$5,658.81
 - (\$ 91.10) – Garden signs
 - \$ 1,025 – Adopt a planter/garden fundraiser

Grow the Holiday Tree Fundraiser

- We have ordered the additional tree height extension!

Town Event Ornament Sales

- We cut the cost of ornaments to \$5 at the 4th of July booth, but we'll call that special "festival" pricing – and charge \$10 again at the holiday season
- We've ordered the tree height extender!!!!!!

Snowflakes

- The cost of the 5 snowflakes is less than expected. We discussed what to do with the extra funds.
- We decided to use it to get additional replacement lights for the snowflakes, and to get additional garland for the holiday tree.

Utility Boxes Update

- Bonnie and Joy are investigating ways to cover the boxes to make them more attractive.

- Wondering about using corrugated roofing metal to cover the boxes.
- Bonnie's neighbor is willing to help us with the design and creation of these – she'll get an estimate.

Highway 24 Sculpture Update

- Bonnie has applied for two grants for this project...she hasn't heard back yet.

Xeric Gardens

- These are all planted and looking good!

Splash Park

- Bonnie noticed that the planters are getting over-watered. Joy will let Ryan know.

Friendship Garden Project

- Bonnie has had two classes with local kids – very successful!
- We discussed having master gardeners help prepare the gardens for instructional purposes.
- We will do clean-up in the fall, and consider planting bulbs.

Benches

- We've received one of the student benches; the second will be delivered in the fall
- Sixline can make them for about \$1500 (including spray coating)
- One student bench can go to the empty lot where The Olive is located; the second student bench will (hopefully) be finished in the fall
- We'll order 2 benches from Sixline to go in front of AVDI

NEW BUSINESS

Plaque for Scheidt Chairs

- Kirk Scheidt had the chairs made this year; the Town is having them coated
- We approved paying for a plaque to honor Mr. Scheidt – the cost is about \$30
- We're planning to submit a newspaper article about the installation.
