Old Business

Funds

- Beautification funding from Town: \$14,740
 - \$ 3,240 – Annual Flowers
 - \$ 4,000 – Black Metal Benches
 - (\$259.41) – student bench
 - (\$350) – custom linings for student bench
 - (\$1900) 2 SixLine Benches
 - \$ 3,000 – 5 Snowflakes
 - \$ 4,500 – 2 Trash Cans
 - (\$2,250) –Deposit to SixLine for trash cans
 - (\$2,250) – Final payment SixLine for trash cans

Town Event Ornament Sales

- Next event is Gold Rush Days August 10-11. Voted to adjust price for ornaments to \$10 for one and \$15 for two. Sign up sheet passed around for volunteers to sell ornaments at the Chamber booth.

- Keep total requested amount of money approximately same but re-arrange quantities of items requested for 2020
